Don't leave valuable items in clear view of passersby and as always report anyone acting suspiciously. If you do need to store power tools and other expensive equipment in sheds, garages or out buildings make sure that the security is up to scratch.

There were no Burglaries again in January. We will continue to focus on our "Dark Night" patrols. Please make our job easier by making it difficult for criminals to target your home. Don't leave valuable and gifts on display and review your security arrangements. Contact the Neighbourhood team if you need advice. Where ever possible make your property an unattractive target. Make sure back/side gates are locked and difficult to open from the outside. Make fences and walls difficult to scale. Alarms, good security lighting and CCTV also act as an excellent deterrent.
